Requirement:

Mandarin Stone currently ships natural stone products to locations throughout the UK, with size loads ranging from single pallets through to full loads. The product, whilst packaged carefully for distribution, is by nature fragile and high value, requiring careful handling at all stages of the process.

Mandarin Stone operates an in-house fleet of vehicles offering specialised services for deliveries requiring facilities such as crane offload.
